****Contestants competing in private interview must be ready no later than 11:45 AM for interviews or 3 points will be deducted per judge.**

**** Contestants are welcome to do a walkthrough rehearsal after registration.**

****Please do not call and ask how many are in your age group. We do not disclose this information.**

- **Baby Doll & Doll Miss (ages 1 - 11 mos.):** Beauty, Casual Wear
- **Baby, Wee and Tiny Miss (ages 12 mos.-6 years):** Beauty, Casual Wear, Physical Fitness
- **Little, Junior, Young, Teen and Miss (ages 7-26 years):** Beauty, Physical Fitness, Casual Wear, Private Interview

Optional Competitions (All Divisions):

- **Baby Doll, Doll:** Best Dress, Most Beautiful, Photogenic
- **Baby, Wee & Tiny Miss (ages 19 mos.-6 years):** Best Dress, Most Beautiful, Photogenic, Talent (Required for Mini Supreme Title)
- **Little, Junior, Young, Teen & Miss (ages 7-26 years):** Best Dress, Most Beautiful, Photogenic, and Talent (Required for Overall Supreme Title)

****NOTE:** The Baby-Miss age divisions must compete in 4 optionals for Mini Supreme and Overall Supreme Titles (one must be Talent). If all 5 optionals are selected, the lowest optional score will be dropped (excluding Talent).

AWARDS and REQUIREMENTS (Age Division Beauty Winners)

- PONC Preliminary Custom Full Round Pearl and Rhinestone Crown, Satin Banner, Trophy, Rhinestone Crown Pin, Beauty fees paid to the Princess of NC State Scholarship Pageant 2023 at Paramount Theatre in Goldsboro
- All Contestants will receive an award.

Overall Supreme Princess of Robeson County and Mini Supreme Princess of Robeson County Winners

***Contestant with the highest combined scores from the mandatory & optional competitions (Awards below):**

- **Baby Doll, Doll, Baby, Wee & Tiny Miss (ages 1 month - 6 years)** will receive a Mini Supreme Full Round Pearl and Rhinestone Crown, Satin Banner, Trophy, Rhinestone Crown Pin, their **Beauty fee** paid to the Princess of North Carolina State Scholarship Pageant 2023
- **Little, Junior, Young, Teen & Miss (ages 7-26 years):** will receive a Full Overall Supreme Round Pearl and Rhinestone Crown, Monogrammed Satin Banner, Trophy, Rhinestone Crown Pin, their Beauty and Fitness fee paid to the Princess of NC State Scholarship Pageant 2023.
- Must have 20 paid contestants for 2 Supreme Titles to be awarded - **The Majestic Queens will be single Title Holders.**
- **If the Supreme Queen is the Community Service queen winner, they will be recognized on stage, but will not be double crowned. The crown will go to the next contestant who raises the most money.**

Princess of Robeson County People's Choice

Each contestant is asked to bring a decorated box or jar with their name and picture on it. The contestant's jar that collects the most money will be crowned Princess of Robeson County People's Choice. **Each contestant is encouraged to raise money for Victory Junction prior to the pageant. This will be added to your People's Choice amount to determine winners. You must turn in money raised for VJ at time of registration.** One dollar counts as one vote. The jar with the most votes collected during pageant plus prior donations will be announced at the end of the pageant. The Winner will receive a Princess of Robeson County full round crown, monogrammed sash, rhinestone crown pin, and reign with the Princess of Robeson County Court. This title also qualifies to compete at the PONC State Pageant. All proceeds from People's Choice will benefit Victory Junction.

Checks may be made directly to Victory Junction or Princess of North Carolina. Please take advantage of this opportunity to win this title before you ever hit the stage!!

Music, Score Sheets & Pictures

All photogenic pictures, talent CD's, and score sheets may be picked up by turning in your contestant number at the auditor's table following coronation.

Admission

- Tickets are \$10 at the door. The doors will open for all spectators depending on each division.
- Visiting queens are welcome at no charge but their chaperone must pay \$10.00. The visiting queen must have a crown and sash current-to-date.
- Contestants are allowed ONE hair/makeup person and ONE chaperone backstage. The H/MU pass is \$20 per contestant and the chaperone pass is \$10 per contestant. Contestants should NOT have more than TWO people backstage at any time.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

Make-up (All Divisions): Make-up is allowed but must be kept age appropriate and toned down. Age appropriate means to consider your age.

Physical Fitness (OPTIONAL for Baby-Tiny Miss): Contestants will wear clothing, including footwear that is worn for sport or physical fitness exercise. Contestants in Little through Miss Divisions may wear an outfit that shows midriff (age appropriate). The activewear outfit CANNOT be embellished. Activewear will be judged on the contestant's physical fitness, overall appearance and their selection of activewear. **Contestants should not perform a fitness/workout routine** but may athletically enter/exit the stage and travel between Xs on stage. They will strike a fitness pose at the X on stage left. **If a contestant performs a fitness/workout routine, three points will be deducted from each judge.**

Beauty (Mandatory Baby Doll-Miss):

- Infant, Doll Miss (Sunday dress, party dress, babydoll dress or cupcake style dress allowed, appropriate accessories)
- Baby, Wee, Tiny Miss (Short pageant dress, white shoes, no tights, dress socks)
- Little Miss (Long or short, but must be long by State PONC)
- Junior, Young, Teen and Miss - (Long pageant dress)

Casual Wear (Mandatory Baby Doll-Miss): Contestants should dress age appropriate, neat and stylish. Casual Wear should NOT have any added embellishments. The outfit may be off the rack or custom made. Hand held props are not allowed.

Private Interview (Mandatory Little-Miss): Contestants in Little-Junior will participate in a 3 minute private interview and Young-Miss will participate in a 5 minute private interview. They should wear an outfit of their choice but it CANNOT be embellished. Private interview outfits should have appropriate shoes and accessories. Three points will be deducted from each judge if a contestant is late for her interview.

Best Dress (Optional Baby Doll-Miss): It will judge the dress (only) during the Beauty Competition and counts only for mini and overall supreme titles.

Most Beautiful (Optional Baby Doll-Tiny): It will judge facial beauty (only) during the Beauty Competition and counts only for mini and overall supreme titles.

Photogenic (Optional Baby Doll-Miss): Must be a natural, "professional," black/white or color 8x10; **With the exception of minor lighting or hair details**, No enhanced photographs allowed; Makeup and photo should be age appropriate; Pictures must be placed inside a clear cover. There will be hard plastic covers available to buy for \$5.00 each at registration. Label the photo cover with division and contestant #; Photos should be head/or head and shoulder shots. Doll & Baby Miss may be waist up.

Talent (Optional Baby-Miss Division Titles); (Mandatory Baby-Miss Mini Supreme & Overall Supreme Titles): CD's ONLY, no tapes. No other songs on CD other than talent selection. Talent may not exceed beyond 2 minutes. Label CD with contestant # and name. The song and talent must be age appropriate! Vocalists are not allowed to have background singers on their music. If you need assistance with finding a karaoke version, please let us know and we will be happy to help. Note - Always have a backup CD with you in case of emergency. Small props are allowed for talent if they can be carried on by the contestant.

Princess of Robeson County Rules and Information

- 1) Contestants must have a valid North Carolina address and reside in or be a resident of NC for at least six months of the year.
- 2) Contestants must be single/never married, or given birth.
- 3) Contestants and/or parents are not allowed to approach the judges at any time during the pageant.
- 4) Judges decisions are final and indisputable.
- 5) Contestants may move up one age division to compete if they or their legal guardian feel it would be in their best interest. At no time are you allowed to move down age divisions.
- 6) When turning in your contestant number, score sheets, talent CDs and photogenic pictures will be available at the auditor's table immediately following the Coronation ceremony. We will not be responsible for keeping or returning any items left behind.
- 7) No props allowed for talent competitions. Exception: a chair/stool as part of the routine or small hand held carry on object. (ask if in doubt)
- 9) H/M people are responsible for bringing their own table, chair, and extension cords, etc. When finished each H/M person is responsible for cleaning up their own area!
- 9) One chaperone and one hair/makeup person allowed backstage and they must have a pass (armband)
- 10) Contestant numbers should be worn on the left side waist area if at all possible. The contestant may walk out with their number and lay it on the stage if it is in the way for talent competition.
- 11) Contestants must be on time for scheduled competitions. We cannot delay competitions to wait for any contestant! It is the responsibility of the chaperone to ensure that the contestant is on time for each event.
- 12) Information on whom or how many are competing in any age group will not be disclosed.
- 13) Please do not leave valuable items unattended in the dressing areas or restrooms! (PORC are not responsible).
- 14) No still cameras, videos, or recording devices are allowed inside the auditorium. Anyone reported to the staff for either of these violations will be asked to put their cameras away and/or removed from the auditorium! An official photographer and videographer will be available for anyone wishing to purchase photo packages or videos if there are enough contestants. There will be additional information available as the pageant time nears.
- 15) Please, no food or drinks allowed inside the auditorium at any time!
- 16) We reserve the right to disqualify any contestant or refuse entry to anyone in this or future pageant for poor sportsmanship or not honoring the duties of their title.
- 17) All 2022 Queens that are crowned will be asked to come back and entertain and give up their title at the following year's Princess of Robeson County Pageant.
- 18) Please keep all hair and makeup natural and age appropriate. No flippers for teeth.
- 19) Talent must be cd ready and on a Music CD-R and turned in at registration.
- 20) Have Fun and let's make a Positive experience for ALL contestants and queens!
